After a recce trip last year to the area, the Invoker Team has recently bought a rubber boat and is now able to reach the island and put a semi-rare EU IOTA reference on the air, the island of San Juan de los Terreros EU-152, not activated since 2004 !



This time the team consists of 4 operators, EA3NT Christian, EA3OR Ramon, EA5KA Raul and F4BKV Vincent. All experienced in previous expeditions and not afraid of heavy pileups.

The team expects to set up at least 2 stations, one on CW mode (operated by EA5KA and EA3NT) and another on SSB mode (operated by EA3OR and F4BKV) which will be helped by an amplifier.

Despite the small size of the island, the team may eventually try to set up a 3rd station QRV for 6m band...or even a 3rd HF band if interferences are not too high.

We are using the same antennas as we recently used in Corsica, during the TKxINT activities.

The team expects to run for 48 hrs non-stop, although we depend very much on weather and sea conditions to stay on the island overnight. Otherwise we may have to QRT during the night and go back early in the morning.

The expedition is expected to QRT on Monday 10th June morning, around 0700utc.
